

Participating in Play on Pedals

Play on pedals is the early year's resource that links into the national **Bikability Scotland Training programme**, delivered by **Cycling Scotland**. Its aim is to give all children across Scotland the opportunity to learn how to ride a bike before starting school.

Our role as a Play on Pedals Instructor will be to teach our children how to ride a pedal bike, through the use of games and play within a safe off road environment.

Each child will have their own groups and set out days that they will be taking part in Play on Pedals. Can we ask that the children attend the nursery before 10am and 2pm on their day as they may miss out on that session. (See below for details on your child's Groups and Days)

All balance and pedal bikes, helmets and equipment will be provided for each session.

Children can bring their own bikes and store them in the summerhouse while in nursery on their Play on Pedals Session day and we would ask that you please take your bike home the same day as we cannot guarantee its safety when the nursery is closed
